



# Financial Pictionary

## How to Play

- Divide the group into two teams and come up with a fun team name
- Determine the “batting order” (who will draw first, second, and so on) within each team
- Identify one member of each team to keep time with a timer or stopwatch
- Set up a whiteboard, easel with paper, or post large sheets of paper where everyone can see them
- Make sure there are plenty of markers, color pencils, or crayons on hand for the artists to create their masterpieces
- Flip a coin to decide which team goes first
- On a team’s turn, a player selects one of the cards from the stack and attempts to draw the word(s) following the rules below
- The player’s teammates try to correctly guess the word (or basic idea of the word) within the allotted time limit (suggested one or two minutes)
- If the team is successful, it earns a point. If not, the opposing team has an opportunity to guess and possibly receive a point
- The teams then alternate turns until all the cards are used

## Rules

- The artist may not make any hand gestures or audible noises
- The pictures drawn cannot have any numbers or letters
- After a team member successfully says part of the word(s) on the card, the artist is not able to give additional hints or encouragement
- If time runs out, the opposing team immediately takes control and can begin guessing

## Variations

- To make it more competitive, allow the team that correctly guesses the word(s) to retain control of the board and continue drawing until it is unsuccessful
- Instead of or in addition to using the prepared clues, have each player write a few clues of their own and shuffle them into the deck
