Winston-Salem, N.C., December 17, 2019 – Allegacy Federal Credit Union is expanding its retail presence into Yadkin County with plans to open a financial center in August 2020. The new location, at 912 South State Street, Yadkinville, will bring Allegacy's total to 18 financial centers.

The new Allegacy financial center will feature the credit union's latest branch experience, designed to offer members a variety of innovative ways to do business via a combination of technology options and opportunities for face-to-face engagement with member advisors.

"As a homegrown credit union, we understand the importance of being a committed part of the community.
